- Exhibitors Card: Exhibitors must own or purchase a 2023 NSSHA Exhibitors or Trainers Card prior to show at this show.
   Card may be purchased at the Entry Desk. Juveniles Cards for Exhibitors 7-17 and Amateur Cards for Exhibitors 18 and Older \$15.00. Trainers Card \$25.
- 4. Spotted Saddle Horse Pleasure 3/8" x 3/4", NO Headshake, Country Pleasure –, stamped cast keg shoe. Trail Pleasure 3/8" 3/4", Performance Classes: Lite Shod 1/2" x 1", Open 1/2" x 1" 1/2". Open Classes indicate riders. Age 12 and Older unless otherwise specified. Classic Performance Class 1/2" x 1 1/2" NO Tungsten Shoes Allowed. Juvenile Performance Class 1/2" x 1 1/2" or less
- 5. Juveniles Age 12-17 Riding in Amateur Classes will receive Points toward Juvenile of the Year Award.
